## Procedure to be adopted in identifying tennis players for National Awards

The Government of Maldives organizes many award schemes to recognize the contribution of sportsman. In many instances, the respective sports association are invited to submit nominations for such awards. As such, the TAM executive committee has decided to adopt a objective procedure for identify nominations from TAM.

## **Nomination**

- Players will be nominated by the Executive Committee of TAM based on the recommendation of Technical Committee (TC).
- The following criteria shall be used by the Technical Committee to evaluate the performance of the players.

#	Criteria	
1	Performance (as measured by national rankings published by TAM)	
2	International Ranking (as measured by ITF/ATF junior rankings)	
3	Other (as measured by rankings in the annual national team	
	selections)	

For the purposes of nominations for national awards, the TC will evaluate ALL eligible players under the above schema.

<u>Criteria 1</u>
Players with top 10 national rankings will be awarded points on the following basis.
