Ranking Rules of Tennis Association of Maldives

(Effective 1st January 2021)

- TAM rankings will be based on the following rules, effective 1st January 2021.
- The rankings will be based on the performance of the players, as measured by the sum of points accumulated over the last three championships organized or sanctioned by TAM.
- TAM will publish the rankings at the end of each TAM championships.
- The weightage attached for each tournament is provided in Table 1 below.
- If a non-Maldivian player wins the Championship or is placed as the runner up player, or attains a position that is eligible for ranking points he/she will NOT be collecting ranking points and ranked in the National Rankings. For example, if a non-Maldivian wins the men's open category in the BML National Championships winning against a Maldivian player, the non-Maldivian will not collect any ranking points and the Maldivian player who attained the runner up position will be awarded 300 ranking points as per the below schedule.

1	BML National Championships	500	300	180	90
2	Tennis Association of Maldives Championships	400	240	145	70
3	Marry Brown Tennis Championships/ other championships	300	180	110	55

The ranking of players as of 1st January 2021 will be based on the points earned in the last 2 tournaments held in 2019 and the only tournament held in 2020.
