<u>Technical Committee decision relating to selection of players for 2025 ATF 12 & U</u> <u>Team competition- South Asia Event</u>

With reference to notice no. N/07/2023 dated 30th January 2023, procedure for composing YDP- First amendment, the Technical Committee has decided to award a wild card entry for the following players.

1. Yousuf Zaain Mohamed Salaam

Rules for the selection of players representing Maldives in the 2024 ATF 12 & U Team competition- South Asia

- 1. The selection matches will commence on Friday 25th April 2025.
- 2. Tournament Director- Alireza
- 3. Including the wild card entry, total of 3 boys and 3 girls will be selected for the team.
- 4. The selection will be played on a round-robin format amongst all eligible players that submitted interest to participate in the selection.
- 5. All matches will be played on a best of three short-sets format.
- 6. In the event of a tie at 4 games all in the first two sets, a normal tie break (7 points) will be played to decide the winner of the set.
- 7. In the event of a tie at 1 set all, the winner will be decided through a super-tie break (10 points).
- 8. 'No-ad rule' will be followed. It means that the first player to reach four points wins the game.
- 9. 'No let rule' will be adopted in all matches. No let rule means: If the serve hits the net, strap or band and goes into the correct service box, the ball will be in play.
- 10. The final standings of each group shall be determined by the following priority:
 - a- Greatest number of points.
 - b- Head to head results (if only two players are tied)
 - c- Highest percentage of sets won
 - d- Highest percentage of games won

- 11. For the purposes of the calculations above, when a match is played with a deciding match tiebreak instead of a final set, the tie-break will count as a set won or lost by one game to nil.
- 12. Each set of a match won by default will be recorded as a 4-0 result. A player winning due to retirement of an opponent will be awarded as many games as are required to achieve a result.
 - For example, if a player retires when winning 2-1 in the first set, his/ her opponent will win the match 4-2, 4-0.
- 13. Each participating player may be required to play 2 or more matches per day.
- 14. All players are expected to attend their scheduled match without fail.
- 15. Players failing to report to a match within 10 minutes of the match being announced will be considered a walk-over, with the opponent declared as the winner.
- 16. No matches may be postponed, under any circumstance. All participating players are advised to avoid any conflicting commitments during the selection period.
- 17. Any player who gives a walk over will be given a warning in the first instance.

 Any player who gives more than 1 walk over will be removed from the Selections.
- 18. Notwithstanding any clause in the rules, Tournament Director reserves the right to amend the rules, where an unforeseen situation/circumstance not covered in the Rules arise during the course of the selection.
