Please attach a clear copy of the player's passport.

Selected players will participate in matches commencing Friday, 28 November 2025.

As decided by the Executive Committee of TAM, for all Junior Development events organized by the ITF or ATF, players are required to cover 50% of the airfare cost.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All players must travel with team to the host nation unless approved by TAM.
2. All players are to stay with the team at ALL times.
3. All player must not leave the hotel or practice venue without permission of the Official appointed by TAM.
4. Parents should not remove players from the team.
5. All events invited by the Organizers are mandatory.
6. All players and parents should conduct themselves in a respectful and courteous manner towards other players, parents, coaches and other officials.
7. All players/ parents must follow hotel rules and club rules.
8. Dress acceptable at meals or events
9. Parents/ players should not interfere with any decisions made by TAM or the appointed officials. Eg. Room allocation of players, training schedule, travel itinerary etc
